

Tent to Tent

Your Tent of Hope journey will connect you with the community around you, but it will also give you the opportunity to connect with the people you are helping, the survivors of Darfur.

Tents of Hope is collaborating with Stop Genocide Now (SGN) and its project, i-ACT (interactive-activism), in bringing together communities here in the US with communities in the refugee camps where displaced survivors live. SGN will allow you to meet and communicate with the very real people that have suffered through unimaginable horrors. Through video and other forms of communication, you will see them, hear their voices, and learn about their hopes and dreams. They will be able to meet you and your community.



Your Tent of Hope will connect you with a tent and the people that live within it. They are counting on our help to assist them in reaching their dreams of peace in Darfur. SGN will facilitate the interchange of letters, pictures, video, and messages of solidarity.

This Tent to Tent connection can be extended to a “Sister City” type connection, with your community committing to a relationship with the people of their “sister tent” and the community around them, a refugee camp, and using this relationship to build awareness, advocacy, and sending direct help that is desperately needed.
